Brooke Weston is the lead school for the DfE designated Northamptonshire Teaching School Hub. We offer a new SCITT (school-centred initial teacher training route) in partnership with Teach First.

Qualification

Trainees will complete a one-year course, achieving QTS and PGCE.

Applications open

Applications are now open for September 2024 across the following:

The SCITT is a one-year, fee paying course.

Trainees are required to meet the cost of fees: £9535 (many apply for a Student Loan for this).

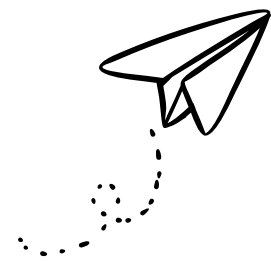
